- Supervise a team of 15.
- Conduct final quality assurance of product and by-product shipments.
- Provide technical help and information for solving non-routine problems.
- Operate the process laboratory to ensure that management, operations and maintenance personnel have accurate, precise
 and timely process information for both process operation and evaluation.
- Operate the wastewater treatment systems including maintenance and operations.
- Maintain technical accounting of sugar and by-products.
- · Conduct analytical methods and automation research for both lab and in-process chemical and physical measurements.
- Conduct process/storage characterization and improvement research.
- Maintain and support business relationship through various committees.
- Other duties as required by the business.
