## Financial Analyst/Business Development

Minn-Dak Farmers Cooperative is seeking a full time Financial Analyst/Business Development (FABD). This position is responsible for assisting the CFO and Manager of Budgeting, Planning and Analysis (MBPA) in preparing business cases, conducting market research, and performing other due diligence responsibilities as required for new business opportunities. This position will also perform analysis pertaining to process improvements and other profit generating activities, as well as assist the MBPA with the preparation of the annual operating budget. The Financial Analyst/Business Development position reports directly to the Manager of Budgeting, Planning and Analysis.

### Essential Job Duties

- Responsible for assisting the MBPA with the Cooperative's annual budget, including the analysis of current and past financial data and performance
- Assist the CFO and MBPA in project due diligence efforts
- Identify, research, and develop financial models for new business opportunities
- Prepare an annual budget for business development activities, including estimated consulting, testing and legal requirements for the business development projects
- Communicates with Cooperative leadership in a timely manner regarding project status, risk, and next steps
- Prepare financial analysis for the Cooperative, which is required for strategic project business cases, special projects, variance analysis, capital expenditures payback and IRR analysis
- Manage project deliverables and timelines, including monthly production and cashflow forecasts
- Assist the MBPA in the preparation of the monthly sugar beet payment estimates and maintenance of the sugar beet payment model
- Assist in the consolidation of historical financial data of the Cooperative
- Perform other duties as required by the business
- Adhere to all company policies and strict adherence to safety guidelines
