



JOB DESCRIPTION

White Centrifugal Operator

Summary

This position operates the white centrifugals in a safe, sanitary, and efficient manner, producing the maximum amount of good quality sugar while taking into consideration the impact of adjustments on the rest of the sugar end.

Principal Working Relationships

- Supervisor Campaign: Sugar End Technician, Shift Superintendent
- Supervisor Inter-Campaign: Shift Maintenance Supervisor or other equivalent supervisor

Essential Job Duties

- The White Centrifugal Operator must operate the white centrifugals in a safe, sanitary, and efficient manner.
- The White Centrifugal Operator must understand and be able to apply their knowledge of the following:
 - ▶ Masecuite pumping and level controls.
 - ▶ Thorough operation of the white centrifugals, including adjustments of wash delay and duration, syrup separation time, spin time, load depth, etc., and their effects on the sugar and the rest of the sugar end.
 - ▶ Basic construction and maintenance of the white centrifugals, including recognition of misaligned sprays or plows, and worn screens, etc.
 - ▶ Juice and water wash supply system, including recognition of abnormal operating conditions, etc.
 - ▶ Granulator room and sugar storage equipment.
 - ▶ Sugar specifications, sugar end and laboratory terminology, and their meanings as applied to the white centrifugals.
 - ▶ Safety, Sanitation, and Food Safety rules and programs.
- Assure that all areas are kept clean within the food safety and sanitation guidelines.
- Complete reports as required.
- Develop the process and mechanical skills of self and others through training.
- Use people, time, equipment, and material in the most efficient manner.
- Report mechanical, electrical, instrumentation, environmental, food safety, feed safety, and operational problems, and unsafe conditions to supervisor.
- Perform other work as directed by supervisor.
- Other duties as required by the business.
- Adhere to all company policies and all safety, food safety, feed safety, and sanitation rules and programs

Qualifications

- High school education or equivalent.
- Process related experience required.
- Prior satisfactory training and competent fill-in as White Centrifugal Operator.
- Should be motivated, willing, enthusiastic, and promotable.
- Good attendance, safety, disciplinary, and overall employment records.
- Ability to communicate and work cohesively with others.
- Inter-campaign maintenance skills greater than or equal to Mechanic IV.
- Organized with excellent time management skills
- Ability to communicate effectively with employees at all levels

Physical Demands and Expectations

- Able to stand or walk on concrete floors for an entire eight hour shift if necessary
- Able to bend and lift – 20 to 100 pounds
- Able to climb stairs
- Able to work in temperature extremes (cold and hot)
- Able to work in noisy and dusty conditions
- Able to work on rotating shifts up to six days per week. A normal shift will consist of eight hours with a scheduled sixth day every four weeks
