Essential Job Duties

- The Utilityperson is involved in preventive and predictive maintenance on, installation of, and identifying and repairing problems on equipment
- Train employees as a Mechanic IV, Mechanic III, and Mechanic II in NCCER levels that have been successfully completed
- Able to plan and execute a job task independently from start to finish
- Properly balance fans
- Assure that all work areas are kept clean within the food safety and sanitation guidelines
- Create and complete service calls, food safety checklists and reports as required
- Develop the process and mechanical skills of self and others through training
- Use people, time, equipment, and material in the most efficient manner
- Report mechanical, electrical, instrumentation, environmental, food safety, feed safety, and operational problems, and unsafe conditions to supervisor
- Complete administrative tasks, duties, and reports as required in a timely manner
- Good attendance, safety, disciplinary, and overall employment records
- Embrace teamwork
- Other duties as required by the business
- Adhere to all company policies and all safety, food safety, feed safety, and sanitation rules and programs and work with and direct
 contractors to insure compliance with our safety, food safety policies and procedures is followed
